# Right to vote

People with learning disabilities and autistic people have a right to vote, same as anyone else.

Please support people to access their right to vote in the upcoming General Election on 4th July.



## Important steps and dates

#### Please support people to:

- Check they can vote in a General Election.
- Register to vote by Tuesday, 18th June, 23:59.
- Decide if to vote in person, by post or by proxy.
- Apply for postal vote by Wednesday, 19<sup>th</sup> June, 17:00.
- Apply for proxy vote by Wednesday, 26<sup>th</sup> June, 17:00.



## Important steps and dates

#### Please support people to:

- Check they have the <u>right type of ID</u>.
- If the person doesn't have the right type of ID, support them to <u>apply</u> for Voter ID by Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> June, 17:00.
- Decide who to vote for check for easy read manifestos. Request easy read manifestos using these <u>templates</u>.
- Find out where the local polling station is (on the person's poll card).
  Find out if it is accessible.
- Vote on 4<sup>th</sup> July, 7 am to 10 pm. Don't forget to bring ID!
